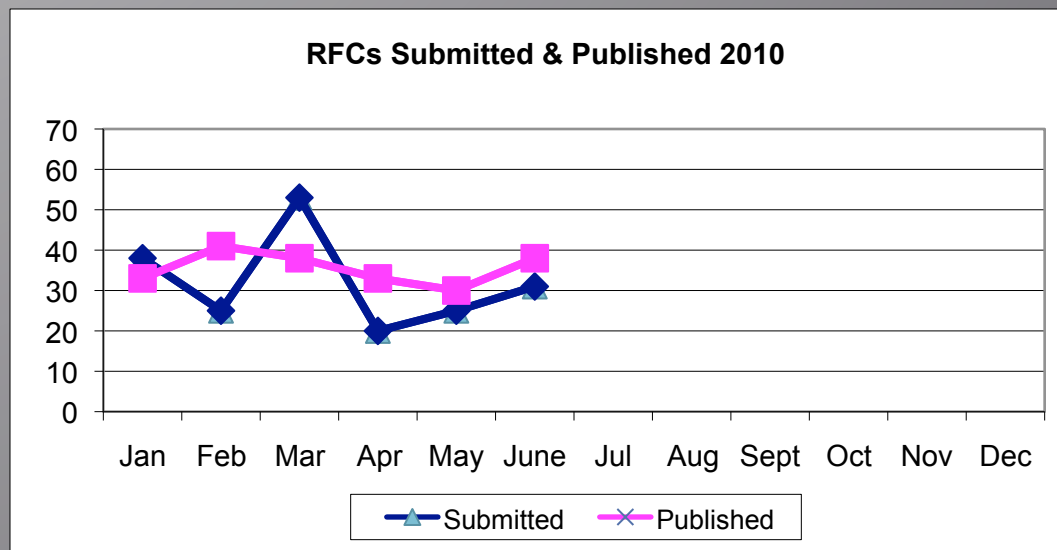
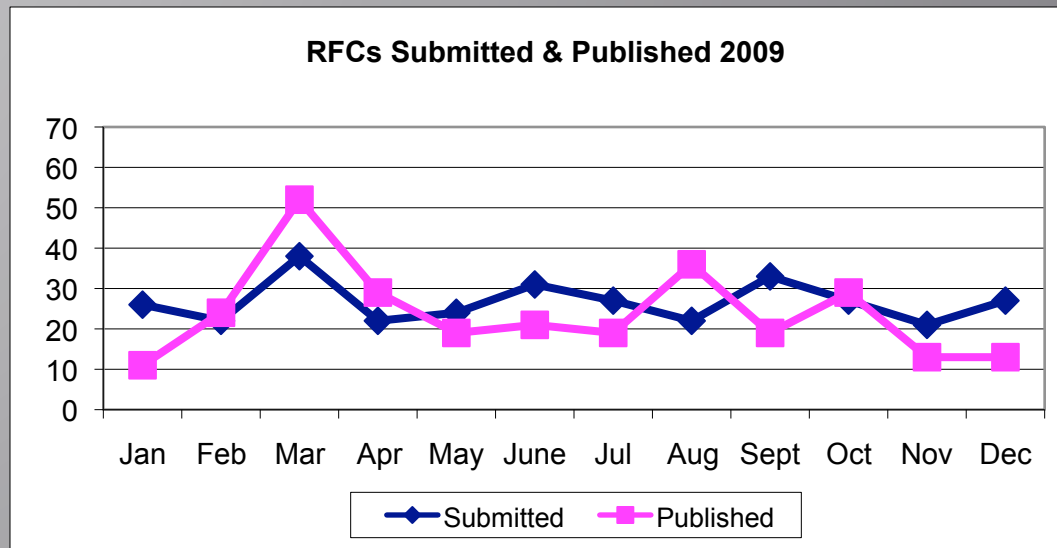

Monthly Sub and Pub Rates

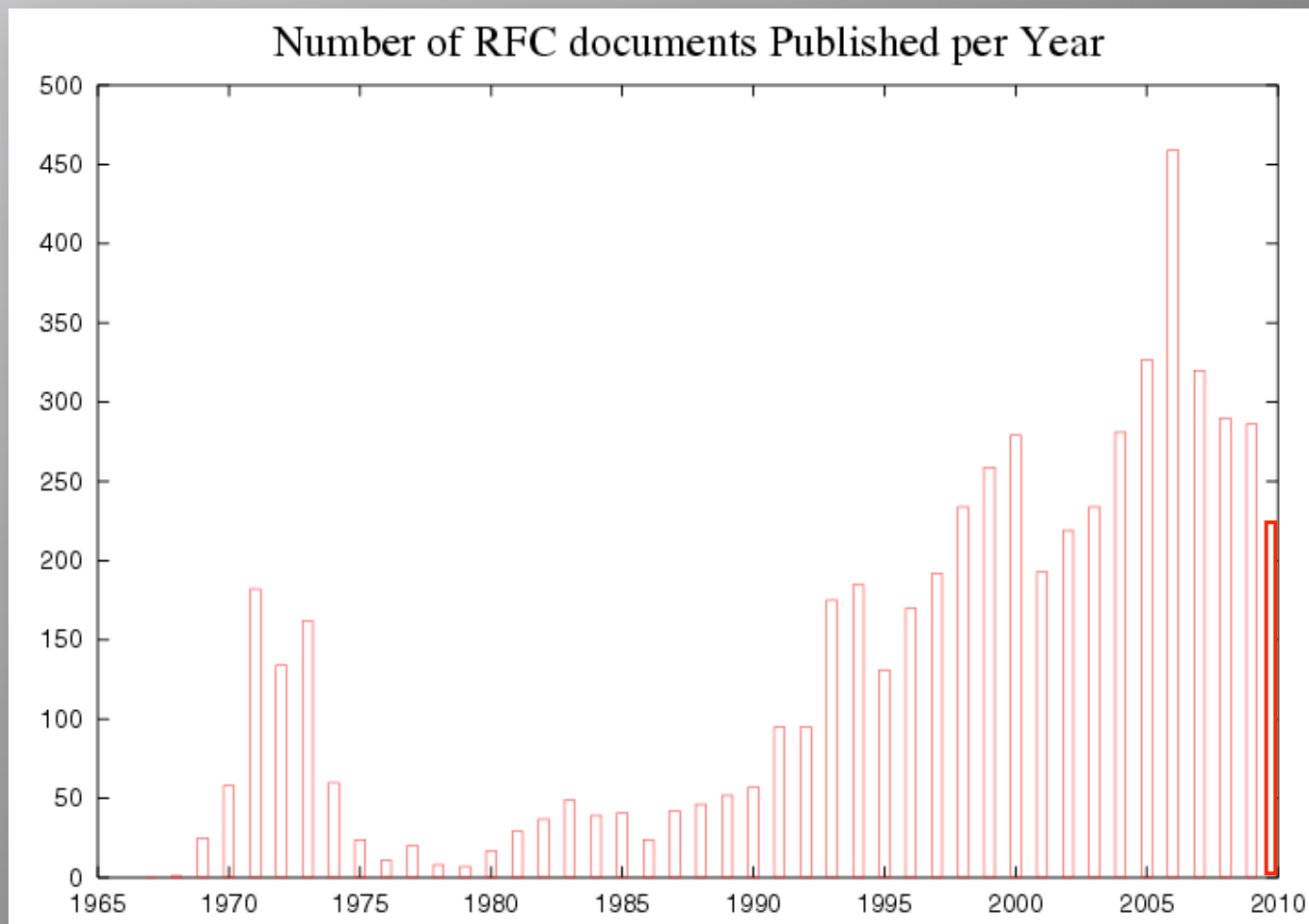

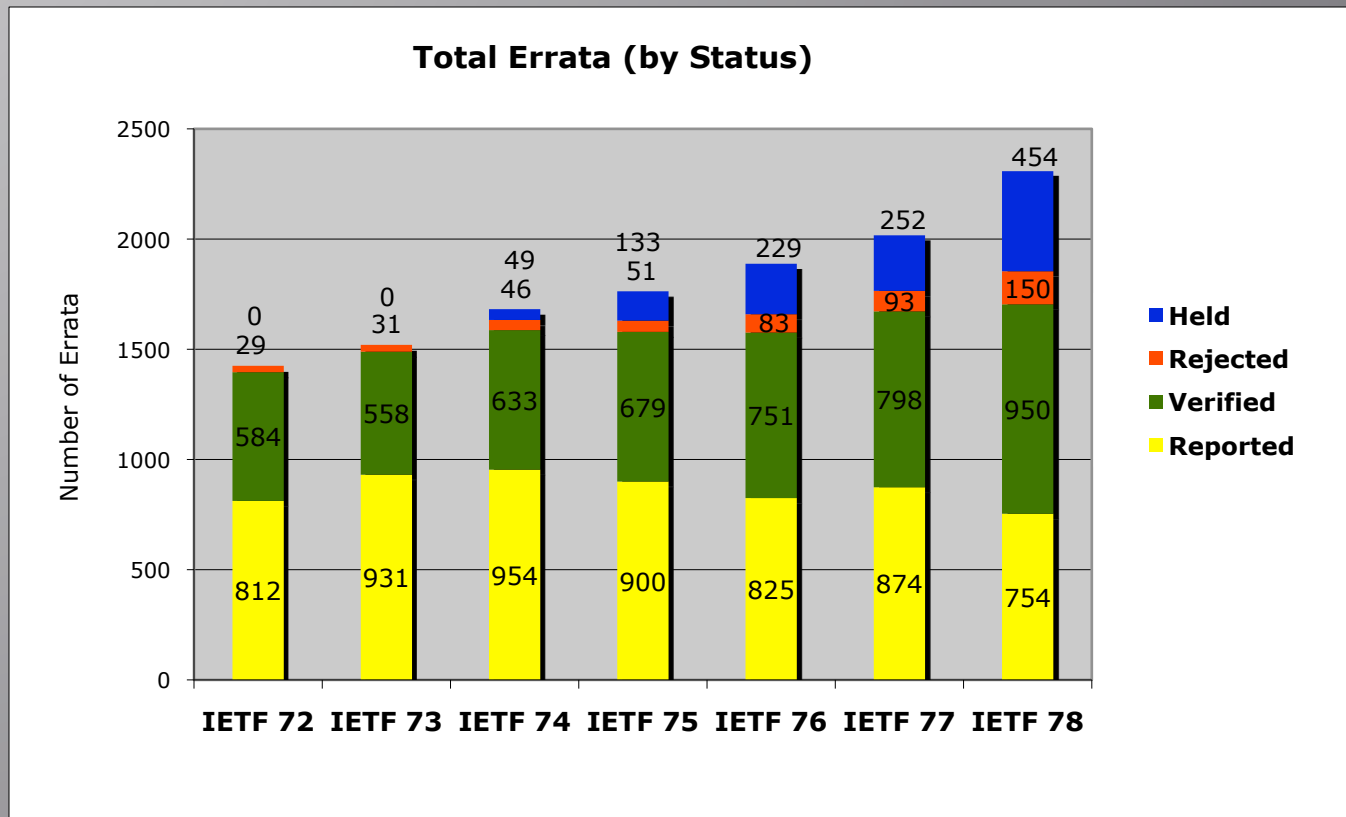

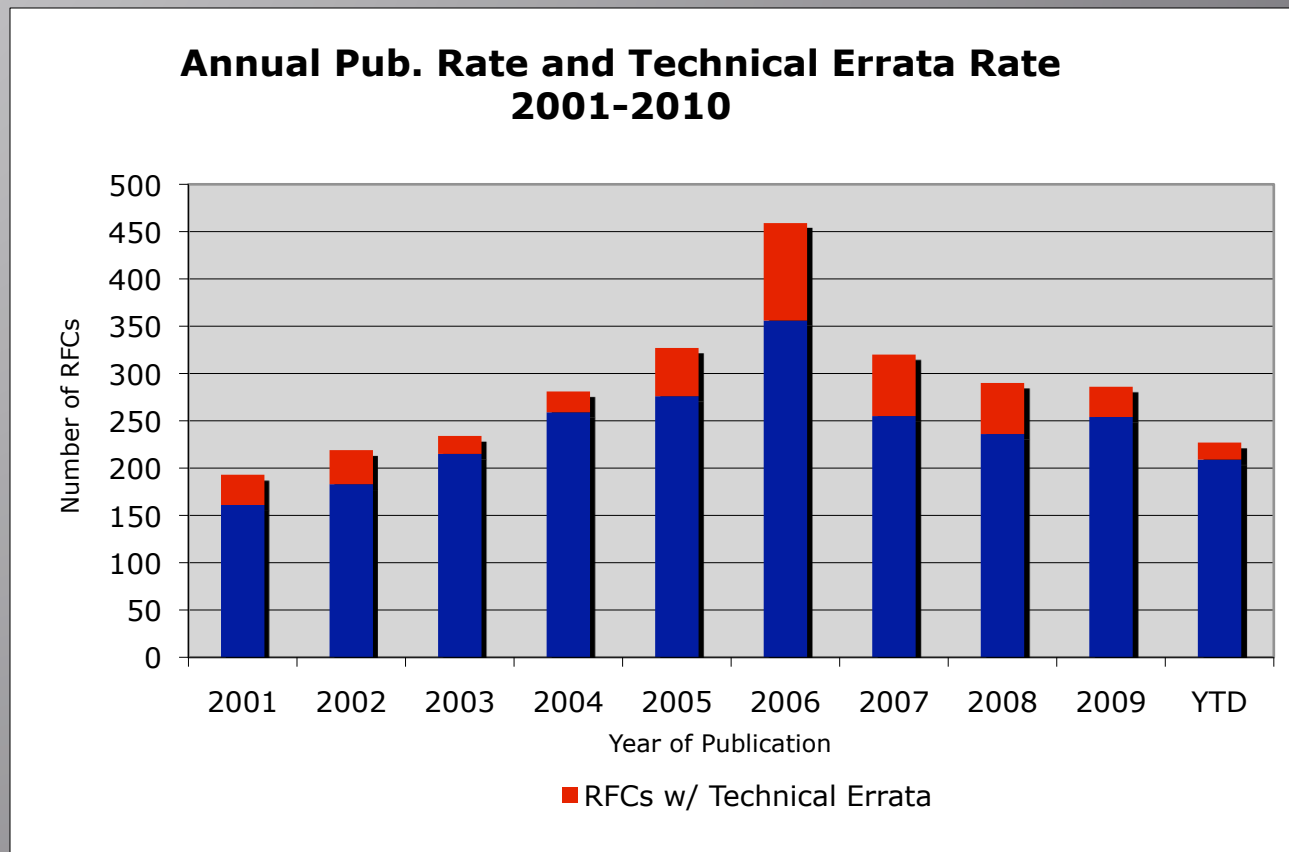
